Partner Campaigns


- Advocate Good Shepherd Hospital link to associate wellness incentives

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Project Metrics

- 45 presentations to over 2,000 people
- Nearly 4,000 Five Wishes distributed (print and online)
- 7 of 13 partners have begun their internal drives
- Barrington Area Ministerial Association (BAMA), one of our partners, represents 17 church congregations.




Website Metrics

- Over 8,200 pageviews
- 73% of those accessing Five Wishes Online (FWO) are women, 27% are men.
- Most prevalent age groups accessing FWO: 55 to 64 (52%), 35 to 54 (30%)
- Most prevalent methods of first hearing about Be@Ease: news stories (37%), employer (33%).

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Learnings

- Metrics Concrete results are hard to come by; think in terms of numbers of people touched
- Advance Care Planning is a PROCESS!
- Partnership initiatives take more time
- One size does not fit all
- Stories make it real
- Engage PR/Media source as a partner
